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If You Park Downhill In

If you are parking uphill, make sure to leave a full car's length of space behind your vehicle. You will need this space to back into the curb. If you are parking on a downhill incline, be sure to leave a full car's length of space in front of your car so that the wheels can roll forward into position.

Parking on a Hill. Uphill: When headed uphill at a curb, turn the front wheels away from the curb and let your vehicle roll backwards slowly until the rear part of the front wheel rests against the curb using it as a block. Downhill: When you stop your car headed downhill, turn your front wheels toward the curb.

Parking on a Hill - What to do if You're Uphill or ...

Keep your foot on the brake as you turn your wheels in the right direction. If you're pulling into a flat spot, just straighten your wheels. If you've parked uphill, you can turn your wheels away from the curb, and if you've parked downhill, you can turn your wheels toward the curb.

Parking signs show you where and when you can park or stop. If you do not follow the rules and the signs, you may get a fine. Parking Advice. Set the emergency brake every time you park. Turn the wheels away from the curb with the truck faced uphill. Toward the curb when facing downhill. Always look for "drive-through" parking spaces. Avoid backing up. If you must back up, ask someone to direct you from the side at the rear. Park in well-lit areas at hotels.

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
