History of the 1966-1970 Jaguar 420 The Jaguar S-Type of 1963 was a shrewd piece of marketing, looking for buyers who fancied the idea of a Mk X, but who also thought that car was too big. The S-Type was developed by taking the platform of a Mk II, streamlining the nose, and fitting slim bumpers and a longer Mk X-style trunk, with significant luggage capacity.
