Either in your doctor's office or in a lab, a sample of blood is drawn from your arm. The sample is then analyzed for levels of important substances, such as sodium and potassium (sometimes called electrolytes), albumin (a type of protein), creatinine (which is connected with kidney function) and certain biomarkers, which can help diagnose heart failure and predict outcomes.
