Nile Cooperation - Key Milestones - Nile Basin At 20

A goal of the NBI has been to establish a "cooperative framework agreement" ("CFA") to replace earlier bilateral treaties and to "formalize the transformation of the Nile Basin Initiative into a permanent Nile River Basin Commission." In April 2010, seven of the Nile Basin states agreed to open the CFA for signature.
