Self-concept clarity is the extent to which one's self-concept is clearly and consistently defined (Campbell, 1990). Theoretically, the concepts of complexity and clarity are independent of each other—a person could have either a more or less complex self-concept that is either well defined and consistent, or ill defined and inconsistent.

Self-concept clarity (SCC) is defined as the extent to which the contents of a person's self-concept "are clearly and confidently defined, internally consistent, and temporally stable" (Campbell et al., 1996, p. 141). Thus, SCC is conceived as a relatively stable person characteristic that can be reliably captured in self-reports.
